
There is an optional pre-cruise night in Vancouver at Skwachàys Lodge - an extraordinary boutique hotel and Canada's first Indigenous arts hotel.

Your Cruise Itinerary

Monday, September 2: Arrive Vancouver, BC (optional NI)

For those who would like to arrive the day before (always a good idea!) we are holding space at Skwachàys Lodge - an extraordinary boutique hotel and Canada's first Indigenous arts hotel. Located in the heart of Vancouver's historic downtown, this stunning addition to the local urban landscape offers guests an authentic Indigenous experience while providing the highest quality personalized service.

Prices vary with room category and range from approximately \$199 - \$240. Prices will be in CAD; these have been converted to USD. Taxes are extra. Skwachàys Lodge was named by Time Magazine as one of 2018 greatest places to stay.



Tuesday, September 3: Sail from Vancouver, BC / 5:00 PM

Prosperous and vibrant Vancouver is Canada's third-largest city and British Columbia's most cosmopolitan center. Enjoy exploring the restored Gastown district or discovering the intrigue of Chinatown. Seize this opportunity to sample delicacies from the sea, explore the North Shore and Stanley Park, the largest natural park of any city on the North American continent, and browse among shops and galleries in Granville Island. Blessed with an unsurpassed natural backdrop, Vancouver is set amid a gorgeous landscape of water and mountains. On a clear day, one can view rugged mountains, emerald-green parklands and the luminous sea from almost any vantage point. You can embark the Crystal Symphony between noon and 3:00 PM. The ship sails at 5:00 PM



Wednesday, September 4: Cruising Queen Charlotte Sound / All Day

The Queen Charlotte Sound lies between the Queen Charlotte Strait, which winds between Vancouver Island and the British Columbia mainland in the south, and Hecate Strait, which is northward, adjacent to the Haida Gwaii Islands off the Pacific coast of British Columbia. It is a broad reach in the long shipping route called the Inside Passage threading the myriad islands stretching from Washington's Puget Sound to Alaska.



Thursday, September 5: Juneau, Alaska, USA*/ 1:00 PM - 10:00 PM

Juneau, the capital of Alaska, is a town accessible only by air and sea. It was founded during the rush for gold in the 1880s and was named after Joe Juneau, the prospector who first discovered gold in this state. Today, much of its independent frontier atmosphere remains. The infamous and rowdy Red Dog Saloon coexists beside impressive modern office towers. It has a superb location, snuggled between the flanks of 3,600-foot Mt. Juneau and the picturesque Gastineau Channel. Mountains, glaciers and the sea are everywhere to be seen. Among its many attractions, Juneau is our gateway to the Mendenhall Glacier, a 12-mile river of ice that is Alaska's most accessible, and most photographed, glacier.



Friday, September 6 Skagway, Alaska, USA / 8:00 AM - 7:00 PM




Discover the flavor of the gold rush era in Skagway. In its heyday, this atmospheric frontier town was the largest in Alaska. During the height of the gold boom, Skagway was known as the gateway to the goldfields, and its population went from 2 to 10,000 in a single year. At one time it boasted 80 saloons and was known as the "roughest town on earth." Although its population is now less than 1,000, its rip-roaring past will come alive as you stroll along Broadway or browse through the Trail of '98 Museum's outstanding collection of memorabilia. In Skagway, we've included a special On The Map Travel Glacier Point Wilderness Safari as a shore excursion. An adventurous combo excursion that has a little bit of everything: a catamaran cruise, easy rainforest hike and a scenic paddling journey that culminates with a face-to-face

view of Davidson Glacier. This Skagway shore excursion is geared towards the active traveler who wants to experience the natural side of Skagway and the surrounding area in a small-group setting. The Glacier Point Wilderness Safari journeys to a true wilderness setting surrounded by awe-inspiring beauty.

Saturday, September 7: Cruising Glacier Bay* / ALL DAY

This stunning amphitheater of glaciers and granite peaks is best viewed from the sea. The ice in Glacier Bay fell as snow centuries ago on the mountains that ring the bay. Compressed by its own tremendous weight, it flows seaward, producing some of the fastest-moving glaciers known. In the summer, rare humpback whales come here to feed – with luck, you'll see one of these gentle giants.

Sunday, September 8: Ketchikan, Alaska, USA / 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM



Ketchikan is the salmon capital of the world and a paradise for fishermen and nature-lovers alike. A quiet city, it hosts quaint restaurants perched on stilts above the water, scores of fascinating shops and spectacular views from every vantage point. Although Ketchikan's Indian name means "Thundering Wings of an Eagle," it is also known as "Alaska's First City," so coined as it is frequently the first stop along the Inside Passage. Venture ashore and discover Ketchikan's rich Indian heritage, visit the world's largest collection of authentic totem poles at Totem Bight and walk along the rustic boardwalk on Creek Street where stilt-buildings in the harbor preserve a distinct pioneer feel. Or, you can paddle a kayak on sheltered waters, take a floatplane to a remote mountain lake or try your hand at sport fishing — all available in "Alaska's First City."

Monday, September 9: Cruising the Inside Passage / All Day

Protected from the open sea by forested isles, sheltered from the windy mainland by the tallest coastal mountains in the world, this 1,000-mile waterway seems custom-made by nature for a cruise. The deep, calm waters of the passage meander between dense pine forests and occasional rustic towns along the way.
